

## COVID-19 GUIDANCE FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE CLUB - updated February 2022

COVID-19 still remains a serious health risk, but the Prime Minister said in his speech on the 21st Feb that because of the efforts we have made as a country over the past two years, we can now deal with it in a very different way by moving from Government restrictions to personal responsibility.

There is no longer a legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test, you will not have to take daily tests or be legally required to self-isolate following contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Public Health Dorset however, is urging residents to continue staying at home if they test positive for COVID-19 or display symptoms of the virus.

In line with Public Health Dorset advice, we request therefore that you do not come to the club if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or if you have tested positive for COVID-19. If you have been at the club and subsequently develop symptoms or test positive, please inform Adam at the earliest opportunity so that we can inform the membership.

The NHS Test and Trace system has been withdrawn and you therefore no longer need to check in at the club on arrival.

Members using the tennis courts may continue to enter via the side gate if required, but use the tennis court door to fob for their courts. If access to the club is subsequently required, please remember to remove/change your shoes, even if you are just using the toilets/booking console.

There are no restrictions on guests or visiting teams playing or socialising at the club, but please advise them of our COVID-19 guidance.

The latest government advice on the steps you can take to reduce the risk of catching and spreading COVID-19 are as follows:

- Get vaccinated.
- Let fresh air in if meeting indoors, or meet outside.
- Consider wearing a face covering in crowded, enclosed spaces.
- Get tested if you have COVID-19 symptoms, and stay at home if positive.
- Wash/sanitise your hands regularly. Please continue to use the sanitisers at the club on arrival/departure.
